She has written four major scientific books dealing with chemistry, cell biology and genetics, and has served on the Prime Minister's Science and Engineering Council.

Williams has written some ten books, including his autobiography *And Now For Something Completely Different*. He is a Fellow of The Australian Academy of Science and in 1998 was voted one of Australia's Living National Treasures.

Science journalist and author

Elizabeth Finkel is an Australian science journalist, best known for her books *Stem Cells: Controversy at the Frontiers of Science* and *The Genome Generation*, and previously worked as a broadcaster for ABC Radio National. Elizabeth is the Editor-in-Chief of *Cosmos Magazine*, Australia's premier science magazine and a Vice-Chancellor's Fellow of La Trobe University.
